## **GAIN STATEMENT (300)**

Madame Chair, Moderator,

The Standing Together for Nutrition Consortium estimates that by 2022 - COVID-19 could result in an additional 9.3 million wasted, 2.6 million stunted children, 168,000 additional child-deaths, 2.1 million maternal anaemia cases and 30 billion US dollars in future productivity losses due to excess stunting and child mortality<sup>1</sup>.

People simply have no choice. The prevention and treatment of malnutrition is essential for every COVID-19 package.

We urge all member states to incorporate the delivery of effective nutrition interventions into national COVID-19 response plans.

We urge All Member States to work closely with the Food System Summit and Nutrition 4 Growth to build integrated strategies to address rising malnutrition.
